Camp Weaver Camper Discipline Policy

The safety of your child, and ALL children entrusted to us, is our top priority. We believe that spending time at Camp Weaver is a privilege, and therefore a camper's behavior should reflect their appreciation. **Camp Weaver has a zero tolerance policy for bullying, inappropriate language and inappropriate behavior.** The following actions will take place when behavior issues occur. An early dismissal does not warrant a refund of fees.

Discipline Process

Behavior: Unacceptable behavior such as not following directions, inappropriate language, disrespect of other campers, staff or property and not following rules.

Action Taken: A counselor will notify a Director. After a conversation with the child, a warning is given.

Behavior: Repeated unacceptable behavior after Director has had a conversation with the child.

Action Taken: A counselor will notify a Program Staff Member or Director. After a conversation with the child, a Director will contact a parent for a conference.

Behavior: Repeated unacceptable behavior after 2 different conversations with the child and a parent conference.

Action Taken: A counselor will notify a Director. After a conversation with the child, a Director will contact a parent and the child will be picked up that day and suspended the next day. Repeated unacceptable behavior could bring about permanent expulsion.

Behavior Warranting Immediate Expulsion

Any illegal activity, or extreme behavior deemed unacceptable by the directors.

Examples include but are not limited to drugs, alcohol, running away, violence, bullying, fighting, behavior that would endanger themselves or other campers.

The Camp Director reserves the right to analyze the information available in each disciplinary situation and make appropriate decisions for the good of the camp community.
