Parent/Guardian Agreement/Waiver

I understand that camp sessions can only be reserved with a \$100 (Overnight) or \$40 (Day Camp) non-refundable and non-transferable deposit. The remaining balance of camp tuition is due two weeks prior to the beginning of each camp session. Any balance not paid two weeks prior to the start of my child's session may be charged on the account given for payment.

I agree not to hold the YMCA or its staff (professional or volunteer) responsible for injuries sustained by my child while participating in camp programs. If I am not available in the event that my child needs medical attention, I hereby give my permission to the YMCA staff or any competent medical authority to render such attention. I accept full financial responsibility for any medical attention or treatment administered to my child in connection with the YMCA camp activities. I carry medical insurance on my child and will provide the YMCA with that information. I fully understand the inherent risks involved in activities my child will be choosing or has already chosen. I accept all risks including those activities preliminary and subsequent to the chosen activities. Activities such as horseback riding, skateboarding, high ropes and target sports (such as archery and riflery) can present a greater risk of injury.

I understand that YMCA policy states that staff is not allowed to connect with summer camp participants via social networks and will face disciplinary action if policy is violated. It is our policy not to allow staff to be babysitters for program participants. In addition we do not endorse or recommend staff to be babysitters even after their employment period with the YMCA.

Camp Weaver has permission to send text messages to the cellular phone numbers provided on this account. I give consent for my child to participate in authorized camp trips and to be transported in YMCA vehicles. Photos, film footage or tape recording of my child may be used for publicity.

I understand that the camp director reserves the right to decline the application of any child, or send home any child who, according to the Director's discretion, is not a desirable associate for the other campers, or puts themselves or others at risk. If a child is dismissed from camp, there will be no refund issued. I agree to read the Parent Packet in FULL. I understand that this form can be found online or that I can contact the office in order to be sent a copy via email, postal mail or fax.
